Dromana Primary School Enrolment Guide

PLACEMENT POLICY

Eligible children and young persons have the right to be admitted to their designated neighbourhood government school.

A student's designated neighbourhood school is generally the school that is nearest the student's permanent address as determined by the school zone.

The website <u>findmyschool.vic.gov.au</u> provides guidance on which school zone a student's permanent residence is located within.

I LIVE OUTSIDE OF THE DROMANA PRIMARY SCHOOL BOUNDARY. CAN I STILL APPLY FOR ENTRY?

Students are able to apply for a place at a school that is not their designated neighbourhood school.

All students who seek enrolment in a school outside of their designated neighbourhood school should be enrolled in that school, if there is sufficient capacity at the school to accommodate all students who apply, or if this request for enrolment aligns with the school's enrolment management plan (if they have one).

It is a requirement of the Victorian Department of Education that we have a copy of the following documents before your child can commence at Dromana Primary School:

Birth certificate (copy)
Immunisation history statement (available
